HK Motorcars Announces the Offering of a Notable  
2006 Mercedes-Benz SLR McLaren, *Signed by Gordon Murray*

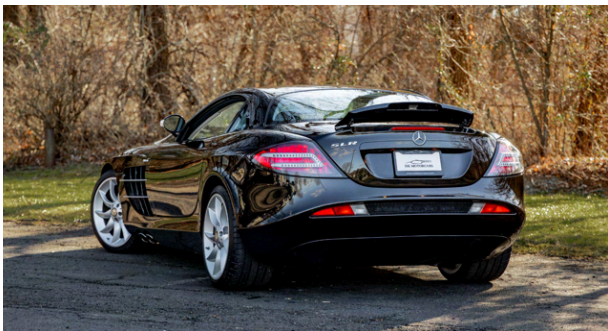
MOUNT KISCO, NEW YORK — **HK Motorcars** is pleased to present a unique opportunity for car enthusiasts and collectors to purchase one of the most iconic supercars to come out of the early twenty-first century: a blue-chip 2006 Mercedes-Benz SLR McLaren. This vehicle represents a significant chapter in automotive history, combining aspects of racing heritage with advanced, next-generation engineering.



The SLR McLaren will undoubtedly go down as one of the most impressive collaborative supercars ever made—but this specific SLR McLaren is even more special. It is finished in

highly-sought after Crystal Galaxite Black exterior paint (with full PPF and a recent ceramic coating), wears only 4,800 miles, and has a full book of service history. Yet beyond that, it is distinguished by being the only known SLR McLaren in the global market to bear a signature from Gordon Murray—the car’s celebrated designer and renowned automotive figure responsible for projects such as the McLaren F1, GMA T.50, and multiple decades worth of Brabham and McLaren Formula 1 cars.

Born from the Formula 1 alliance of Mercedes-Benz and McLaren Automotive, the SLR McLaren simply epitomizes the ethos of grand touring cars. The car is inspired by the legendary 1955 Mercedes-Benz 300 SLR *Uhlenhaut Coupé*—an enclosed derivative of the dominant *monoposto* 300 SLR race car—and it showcases proven Formula 1 aerodynamic finesse while redefining the synergy between road-going comfort and upper-echelon, high-speed performance.

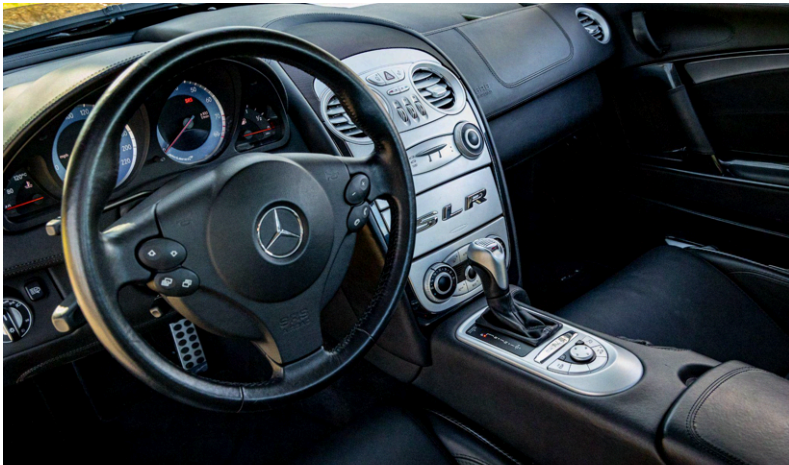


Powered by a 5.4-liter supercharged V8 engine—the first motor to be built in-house by AMG—the SLR McLaren produces 617 horsepower and 580 ft-lbs of torque. Its performance credentials speak for themselves, with a top speed of 208 miles per hour and acceleration from 0 to 60 mph in 3.4 seconds. The car’s construction includes a carbon fiber monocoque and active aerodynamics, like its rear spoiler, contributing to its handling and stability.

The vehicle further showcases advanced construction techniques with its carbon-ceramic brakes and Sensotronic Brake Control, a sophisticated brake-by-wire system. At higher speeds and under hard braking, the rear brake lights will glow much brighter than normally, a distinctive tweak made possible by this system. In general, the collaboration between Mercedes and McLaren is evident in the car's design, blending style with technical prowess.
